ROAD SAFETY -

The school continues to work with representatives from the Road Safety Section of the DoE, and I thank parents for their co-operation and assistance with the movement of traffic in and around the school. Mrs Gates and Mrs Butterworth and staff do a sterling job at the beginning and end of each day. Many staff have missed class time when performing this duty of care. However, we are refining the system and class teachers are leaving the Kiss and Drop Zones at 9.00am in readiness for class at 9.10am. The following actions will assist the staff in continuing to manage the traffic situation:-

- ◆ Park in the street or at Rofo Park and walk to the school entrances.
- ◆ If using Kiss and Drop Zones, please come between 8.40am and 9.00am. We would like all staff to be able to return to their positions in the school by 9.05am.
- ◆ Please park as close to the kerb as possible. Staff should not step onto the road. If they do and have an accident, they are not covered.
- ◆ Thank you to parents and students who have bags ready to go. Please continue this.

Please remember Ida Street is NOT a Kiss and Drop Zone. Drivers stopping in the turning circle are breaking the law. The signs clearly say **"NO STOPPING"**.

ENROLMENTS FOR 2021 -

Enrolment for Kindergarten 2021 are open. We have received a number of applications, but approximately 40 are outstanding. Please remind friends, relatives and neighbours that the forms should be returned as soon as possible so that the staff and I can plan for 2021. A reminder that we are not permitted to enroll siblings if it is an Out of Area enrolment, except in "exceptional circumstances".

Parents are now able to submit enrolment applications online. Following is the advice from the Department of

Education:-

We are excited to announce we will be rolling out the new Online Enrolment System from Monday, 10 August 2020. The Online Enrolment System is designed to provide flexibility for our parents to submit an enrolment application online and at the time that best suits you. The application can be accessed on all browsers and mobile devices including iOS and Android.

The online application process is currently restricted to:-

- * Enrolments into **local** schools only.
- * Children who are Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens or permanent residents.
- * Children who live in NSW.

We offer our support and encourage you to complete your application to enroll online. If, however, you do not feel comfortable completing an application online, a paper copy will be available for collection from the Office or can be downloaded from the Department's [going to a public school site](https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/going-to-a-public-school/enrolment) -

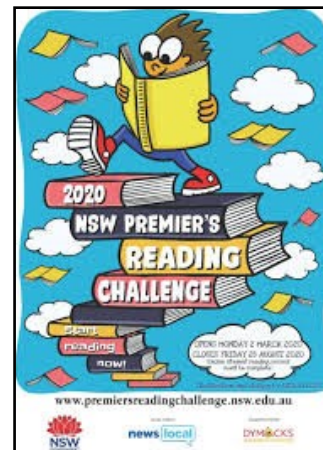
