UNIFORM UPDATE

As we transition into the cooler months, we want to remind all families about our school uniform policy. OPPORTUNITY CLASS AND SELECTIVE HIGH SCHOOL TESTS

We would like to inform parents that the Opportunity Class and Selective High School tests will be taking place this Friday through Sunday. These tests are crucial for students applying for placement in Opportunity Classes and Selective High Schools for the upcoming academic year.

It is essential for parents to log in to the application portal and print off an Admission ticket for their child. This ticket serves as proof of registration and must be presented at the test centre on the day of the exam.

Here are a few steps to ensure a smooth process:

- Log into the Application Portal: Use your credentials to access the portal where you submitted your child's application.
- 2. **Print the Admission Ticket:** Locate the Admission ticket section and print it out. Ensure your child brings this ticket on the test day.
- 3. **Test Day Preparation:** Remind your child to get a good night's sleep before the test day, and encourage them to have a nutritious breakfast. Arrive at the test centre early to avoid any last-minute rush.


HORNSBY MOBILE BLOOD DONOR CENTRE



Intermediate: Thursdays from 8:00am to 9:00am, starting on 1 May 2025

Beginner: Thursdays from 8:00am to 9:00am, starting on 1 May 2025

Learning and playing chess helps children develop their logical thinking and problem solving skills, improves their concentration and focus, while also being a great source of enjoyment. Activities include group lessons on a demonstration chess board or interactive whiteboard, puzzle solving and fun practice games.

Students earn merit awards by making checkmates, or by displaying skills and positive qualities, which all good chess players strive to develop.
